



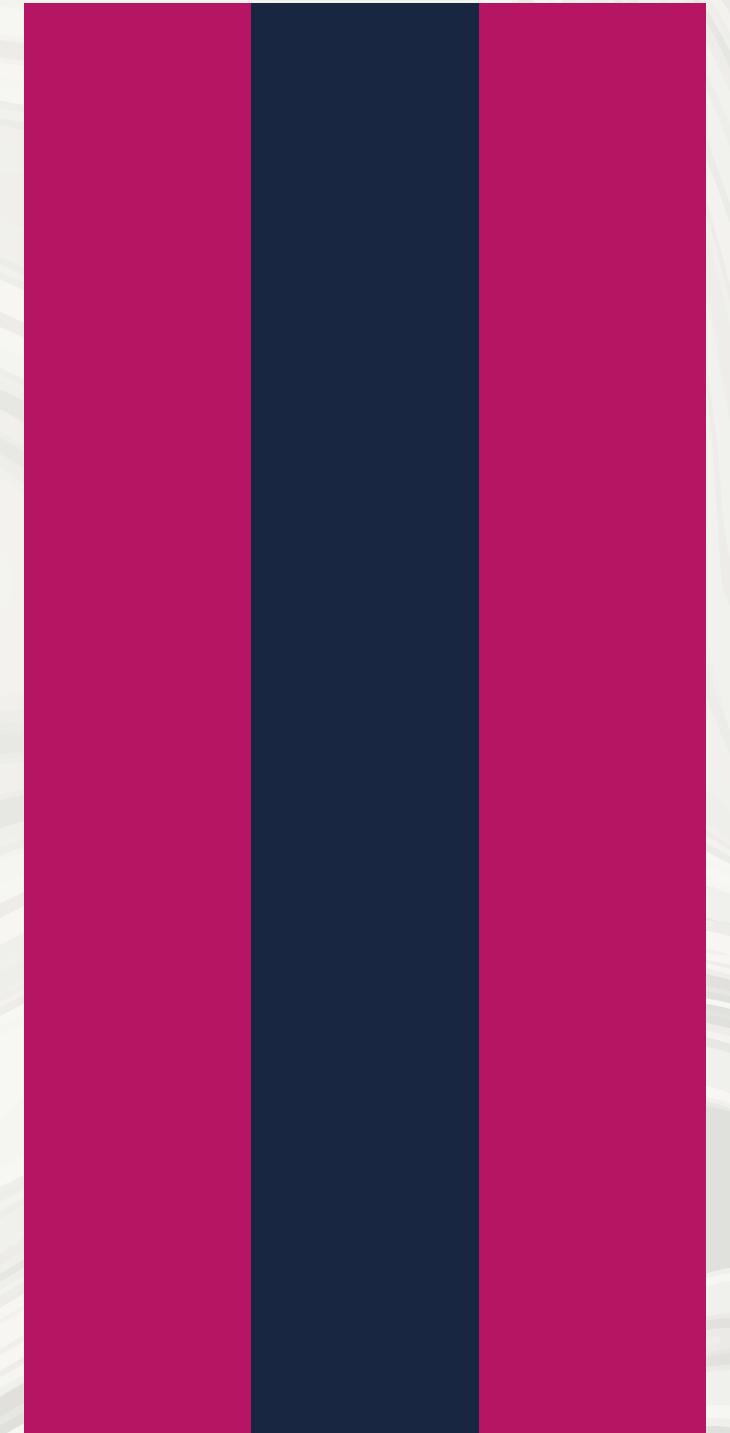

FC EVOLUTION - SAFEGUARDING AT OUR CLUB

For Players & Parents – What YOU Should Do

- Speak up if you're worried – tell your coach, our Child Welfare Officer, or a trusted adult.
- Share honestly – explain what you've seen, heard, or experienced.
- Don't stay silent – even small concerns matter, if something doesn't feel right, it probably isn't
- In an emergency – if someone is in immediate danger, call 999.

What the CLUB Will Do

When a concern is raised, FC Evolution will:

1. Listen carefully and take the concern seriously.
2. Record what was said/seen clearly and factually.
3. Share with the CWO (safeguarding lead) straight away.
4. Decide next steps – this may include speaking with parents or, if needed, external agencies.
5. Keep it confidential – only those who need to know will be told.
6. Follow up to make sure the situation is being managed and the player feels safe.
